ACCESSIBILITY INFO

Black Deer aim to cater for all access needs to ensure everyone has an enjoyable time at the festival.



THE LAND

The festival is held on a green field site with some flat and some undulating areas throughout. As with most outdoor sites the terrain can be uneven in places.



SERVICES

Black Deer Festival offers several facilities and services onsite including:

- Dedicated Accessible Campsite - Close to accessible carpark and arena entrance
- Dedicated Accessible Car Park
- Accessible viewing Platforms – Capacity is limited and at busy times those able to stand may be asked to make way for those unable to do so
- Wheelchair and Scooter charging
- Refrigerated medicine storage
- 24-hour Medical & Welfare Centre
- Accessible Toilets – Located across the festival

- Accessible Shower Rooms – Located within the accessible campsite



ASSISTANCE DOGS

Assistance Dogs are welcome onsite.



DEAF CUSTOMERS

Unfortunately, we do not have BSL / Sign Language interpreters at the festival this year.



CARER / PA TICKETS

We offer Free Carer / Personal Assistance tickets with the purchase of a festival entry ticket (Day or Weekend).

TRAVEL & PARKING

Dedicated Accessible Parking is free for all those that have pre-registered or arrive on the day with a Blue Badge. It is located close to the Accessible Camping field and Arena Entrance.

Customers registered for Accessible Car Parking or Accessible Camping (including those in a live in) should enter the festival via Red Gate.

You need to submit a copy of your blue badge or associated document through the online application form at the bottom of the Accessibility Information page [here](#) or by emailing accessibility@blackdeerfestival.com

Customers confirmed for accessible parking will have their parking tickets emailed to them before arrival to site.



CAMPING

A dedicated Accessible Campsite is located close to the Accessible Carpark and Arena Entrance.

Spaces in the Accessible Campsite are limited, and you must purchase specific camping tickets for this area [here](#).

The Accessibility team are based in this campsite and will be able to assist if required.

If you are bringing a live-in vehicle (including caravan) into the Accessible Campsite you will need to purchase a live-in vehicle pass (1 per vehicle)[here](#).

If you require electric hook-up this is an additional purchase and can be selected when purchasing your live-in vehicle pass.



SUBMITTING SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

It is mandatory to provide one of the following forms of documentation in your application as evidence of your requirements and/or to be granted a PA ticket. These can be submitted through the online application form at the bottom of the Accessibility Information page [here](#) or by emailing accessibility@blackdeerfestival.com

Documents accepted are:

- DLA Letter – care and / or mobility – You will need to submit the middle / higher rate for a PA / Carer ticket
- Personal Independence Payment (PIP) – You will need to submit enhanced daily living or mobility rate for a PA / Carer ticket
- Front page of Attendance Allowance letter – No specific rate required
- Evidence that shows you are registered severely sight impaired (blind) or deaf
- The Access Card or equivalent with a +1 Icon for a free PA ticket
- Recognised Assistance Dog ID card
- War Disablements Pension
- Armed Forces Independent Payment
- Medical Profession Letter
- Blue Badge – for accessible parking requests only

We will keep these documents secure, and once we have reviewed them we will immediately and securely destroy them.
